Notes: Today's prelude is a setting of the Gloria as it would have been sung in the early German church. The German title (rather than Latin) indicates that this would have been used after the beginning of the Protestant Reformation. Utilizing some of the features available on the organ, it will be played in a more accurate tuning and pitch setting than what is used on modern organs. Since the majority of congregants in the early church were illiterate, learning the music could only be done by rote. Therefore, early music was often sung very slowly, as reflected in this morning's prelude.
