CHRISTMAS EVE CANDLELIGHTING: Hymn #253 (CELEBRATION Hymnal)

*“Silent Night, Holy Night”* (Please hold the candle vertically to give the light. Hold the candle horizontally to receive the light. You may say ***“The light of Christ be with you”*** as you pass the light. Repeat hymn until everyone’s candle has been lit.)

**Silent night, holy night! All is calm, all is bright, Round yon virgin mother and Child! Holy Infant so tender and mild, Sleep in heavenly peace, Sleep in heavenly peace.**
